IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- Student domiciled in West Bengal only is eligible to apply
- Institute must be located in West Bengal
- Student with at least 50% marks are eligible to apply (except for Class I)
- Annual family income of the applicant for pre & post-matric is upto ₹2 lakhs and for merit cum means is upto ₹2.5 lakhs
- One mobile number can be used for the registration of one application only
- Students must have their own bank account number. However, for Pre-matric, students can apply through their parents' bank account also
- Print-out of application along with a

- photocopy of bank passbook containing bank account no. and IFS code to be submitted to the concerned institute
- A student is eligible for applying scholarship from any one source only

The minimum qualifying marks for being considered for award of scholarships will be 60% in aggregate, in Madityamik Parischa, and the total marks obtained in the Madityamik Parischa excluding pass marks in the additional subject if any, will be the sole criterion for consideration. Conditates from outside the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education will not be eligible to apply for this scholarship.

For Diploma Courses (Polytechnic under DTE&T) - level:

Students who are enrolled after passing out in Secondary (M.P.) Examination or its equivalent as stated above in 2022 for first year Diploma (Polytechnic) courses (P.S.

Candidates for different categories will submit their applications online in the scholarship portal and applications to scholarship cases would be arranged in descending order (on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination apart from income/means criteria), and scholarship would be sanctioned as per the availability of fund and strictly on the basis of the merit list. fund may be transferred to the beneficiaries account if the documents are in order.

for renewal of scholarship, application must be submitted online to the concerned scholarship sanctioning authority within one month from the date of his/her admission in the next higher class due to promotion by passing in the first attempt (in case of Semester mode All Semester Examinations need to be cleared in the first attempt). Renewal cases (concentrated only at a particular level of study) will be sanctioned subject to good academic performance (Minimum 60% marks should be obtained from Higher Secondary Level to Undergraduate Level(combining both semester) at the promotional examination) and 50% marks (combining both semester)

Oasis Scholarship

Oasis scholarship initiated by the Department of Tribal Development and the Backward Classes Welfare Department of West Bengal enables students from the SC/ST and OBC categories to pursue their higher education. The candidates can apply for the WB Oasis scholarship online through the official portal. Besides Oasis scholarship, the West Bengal government provides other scholarships for minorities, merit students and others.

The West Bengal domiciles who meet the requirements can apply to the Oasis scholarship. The objective is to motivate students aspiring to higher studies.

Eligibility-

The candidates from SC/ST and OBC categories studying class XI and above can apply to the post-matric Oasis scholarship. The eligibility criteria are as follows:

They should belong to the SC/ST or OBC category.

Students of class XI to postgraduate level can apply to the Oasis scholarship.

The family income of the SC/ST students should not exceed INR 2,50,000 per annum.

The family income of the OBC category students should not exceed INR 1,00,000 per annum.



The Annual Scholarship is for unmarried girls aged 13-18 years enrolled in classes VIII-XII in government recognized regular or equivalent open school or equivalent vocational/technical training course.

The One-time Grant is for girls turned 18 at the time of application, enrolled in government recognized regular or open school/college or pursuing vecational technical training or sports activity or is an immate of Home registered under J.J. Act 2000.

Both the benefits under the scheme will be granted to girls who belong to families with annual family income not more than Rs. 1, 20,000/- (Rupees One Lakin and biventy thousand entry. The bar for family is not applicable if the girl has lost both parents, is physically challenged (40% disability) or is inmate of J.J. Homes.

Given that child marriage has a groudy negative impact on the lives of children adolescents and young women, this scheme is expected to bring about improved outcomes in terms of their educational status, health (especially facilitate the provention of infant and maternal mortality) and contribute towards the empowement of the girls in the State, and bring immeasurable benefits for the larger society as a whole

Target Beneficiary

- 1. All girl children within the age of 13 to 19 years from families with annual income up to Rs 120000/-
- Girls regularly attending institutions for education or vocational/sports training
- 3 Girls of Child Care Institutes registered under J.J. Act within the age of 18-19 years
- 4. For the one-time grant, girls who are completing 18 years on or after 1st April 2013.
- 5. Approximately 16 Lakhs girl students for annual scholarship each year
- 6 Approximately 3.5 Lakha girls for one time grant each year
