

Structure of the Programme:

At 10.45am Nature Club members & student volunteers assembled in Room A 1 in the ground floor of College's Main Building. Har Ghar Tiranga campaign was held, where all the nature club student volunteers including teacher members participated and visited local areas/houses to distribute small cotton Tiranga (Indian Flag) for hoisting on 15th August, 2022. Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav holds immense significance as it reminds us of the values and principles that formed the foundation of independent India.

**Outcome:**Plastic Flexi banners, composed of non-biodegradable polyvinyl chloride (PVC), contribute to environmental pollution when disposed of improperly. The burning of PVC can release toxic chemicals, posing threats to ecosystems and human health. Different studies have shown microplastics significantly damage cells in the human body, leading to serious health effects, including cancers, lung disease, and birth defects.



## 2. BBKM INITIATED AN IMPORTANT ROLE TO SAVE MIGRANT BIRDS IN BALAGARH BLOCK IN JOINT EFFORTS OF NATURE CLUB, ANIMAL WELFARE AND NSS PLACE-NATAGARH, SOMRA, HOOGHLY

#### DATE- 9 OCTOBER TO 11th OCTOBER, 2022

Migratory birds fly hundreds and thousands of kilometres to find the best ecological conditions and habitats for feeding, breeding and raising their young. When conditions at breeding sites become unfavorable, it is time to fly to regions where conditions are better. Generally as the college is situated in rural area the students are nature loving and fond of animal caring usually, migratory birds fly in the Balagarh Block, Hooghly from abroad to rural Bengal in winter session. On 9th October, 2022 the NSS volunteers informed their NSS Program Officer of this college that many migratory birds had arrived in a nearby village in Somra. The villagers are killing and eating several migratory birds. They informed it to the master on the 9th October evening over telephone. The college took immediate action to save the migrant birds, as on 10th October, 2022 NSS Program Officer, Nature Club senior member and also the Principal of the college along with nature committee student members and NSS volunteers/Animal friendly students& Nature members from the college rushed there and warned the villagers about their bad practices. The college requested the villagers to stop their illegal killing on migratory birds. The college also informed the Somra Panchayet about the crisis. The PANCHAYET AUTHORITY took measure immediately to stop the local from such bad practices.




