Yuva-Divas (Birthday of Swami Vivekananda- Online celebration):

Yuva Diwas is celebrated on January 12th each year to commemorate the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda,(born on 12th January 1863) a revered spiritual leader, philosopher, and youth icon in India.
