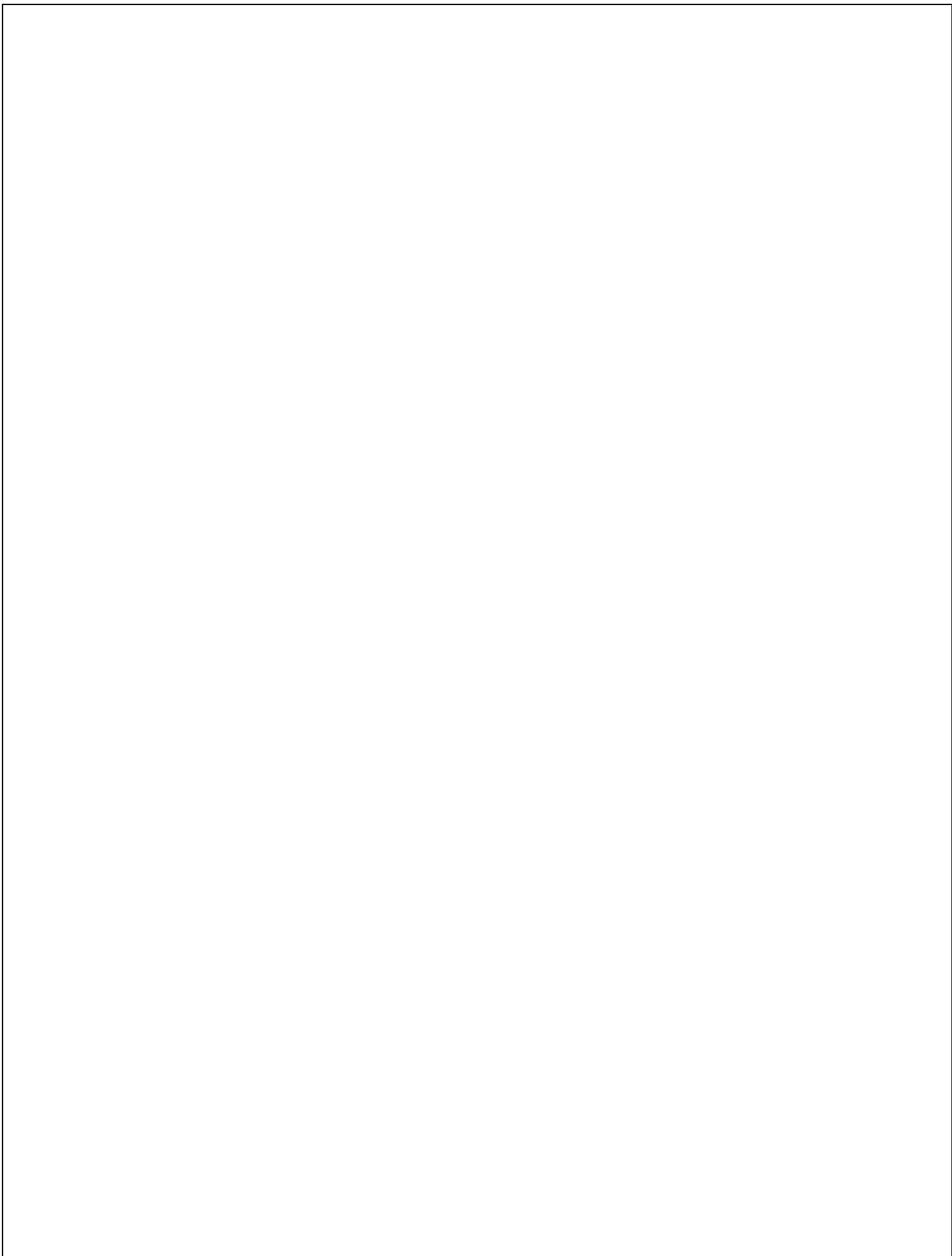

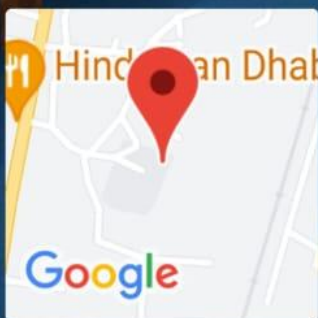

Russia-Ukraine Crisis: Position of India

Abstract of the speech

Russia's invasion of Ukraine is the biggest military mobilization in Europe since World War II. Now following the launch of Russia's full scale invasion on Feb. 24, 2022, the largest mobilization of forces Europe has seen since 1945 is underway. Relation between two countries became hostile after the 2014 Ukrainian revolution which was followed by Russia's annexation of Crimea from Ukraine, and due to Russia's backing for the separatist fighters of the Donetsk People's Republic and the Luhansk People's Republic in a war, conflicts that had killed more than 13,000 people by early 2020. Now, the question is what was Putin's original goal? The Russian leader's initial aim was to overturn Ukraine and depose its government ending for good its desire to join the Western defensive alliance NATO. After a month of failures, he abandoned his bid to capture the capital Kyiv turned his ambition to Ukraine's east and south.

Launching the invasion on 24 February, he told the Russian people his goal was to "**demilitarize and de-Nazify Ukraine**". He declared aim was to protect people subjected to what he called eight years of bullying and genocide by Ukraine's government. Another was soon added "**ensuring Ukraine's neutral status**". The claims of Nazis and genocide in Ukraine are completely unfounded but part of a narrative repeated by Russia for years. However, an opinion piece by state-run news agency Ria Novosti made clear that "denazification is inevitably also be de-Ukrainisation".—in effect erasing the modern state. And it is Russia that is now accused by the international community of carrying out of war crimes. Several countries including US and Canada go further call it genocide. After so much destruction, the Russian leader's words might very hollow now." It is not our plan to occupy the Ukrainian territory, we do not intend to impose anything on anyone by force.

India's response to the Russian invasion of Ukraine has been distinctive among the major democracies and among U.S. strategic partners. Despite its discomfort with Moscow's war, New Delhi has adopted a studied public neutrality toward Russia. It has abstained from successive votes in the UN Security Council, General Assembly and Human Rights Council that condemned Russian aggression in Ukraine and that far has refused to openly call out Russia as the instigator of the crisis. An Indian scholar has called this stand of India in Ukraine crisis as "a subtle pro-Moscow position". Russia is viewed as having been a sturdy friend of India's going back to 1955 and remained as a major weapon supplier from then to now.

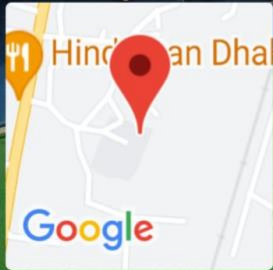
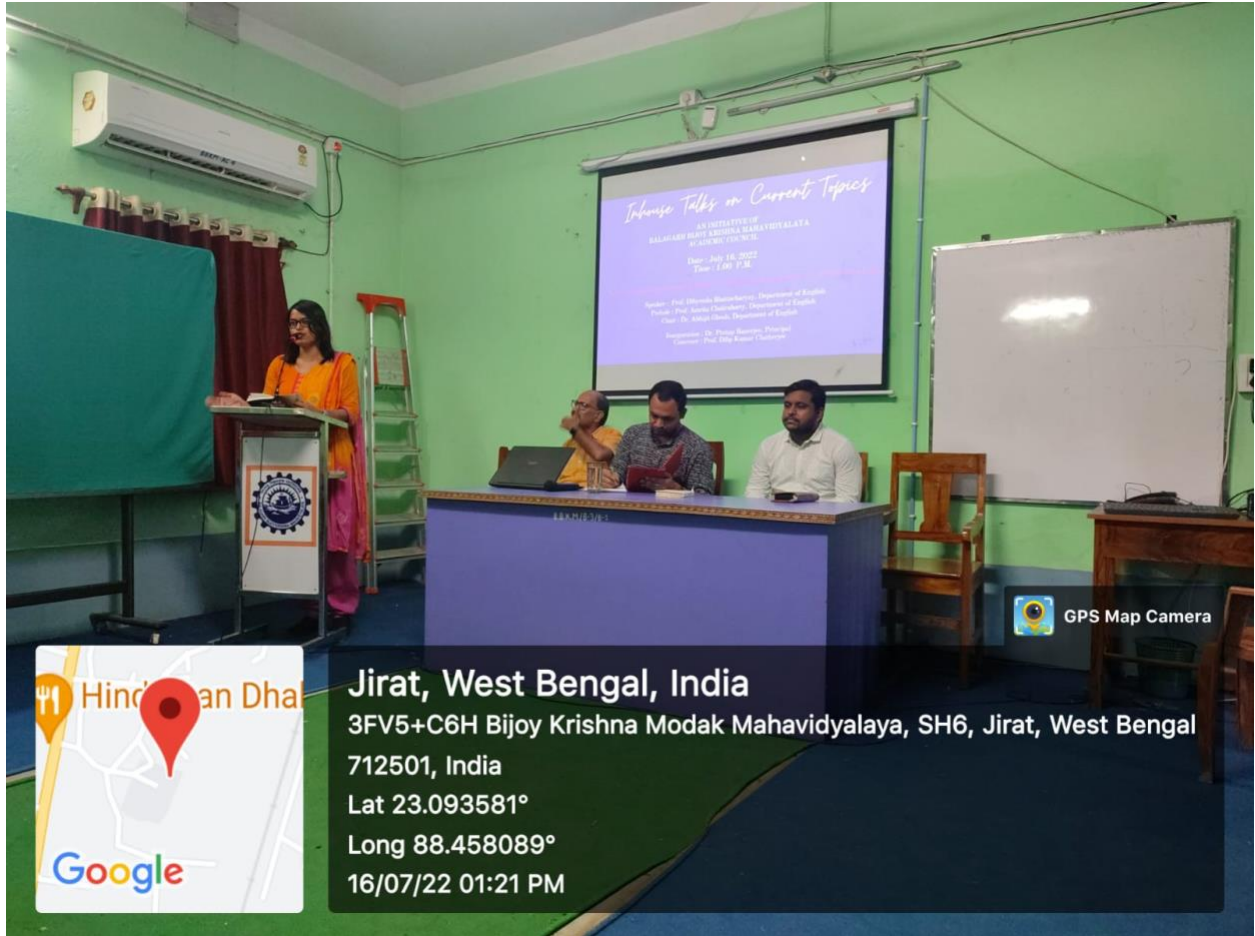

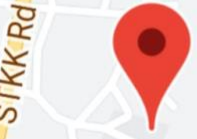
