Sub-Establishment of a dogree, college at Balagarh District of Hoogkly.

The undersigned is dimeted, by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to approve of the proposal for the establishment of a degree college at Balagarh in the district of Hooghly W.s.f. the academic session 1985-85 subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) The organisors shall have to provide the required land as assessed by the University Inspecting Team by way of registered deed, free from all encumbrances to the college authorities.
- (2) The organisers shall be required to provide adequate accommodation for conducting classes, cifice and teachers and Principal, essential furniture and common-room for students, equipment, books, etc for purpose of the college as per standard laid down by the University at their own cost:
- In case of delay in constructing the permanent building the college authorities should provide a temporary structure compisting of at least three rooms.
- (3) Adoquato Camitary arrangement 1.0. toilets and urinals for students and members of staff shall be made.
- (4) Arrangement should be made for adequate supply of drinking water.
- (5) The college shall not be permitted to run Higher Secondary Courses.
- (6) The college will be run by a governing Body to be constituted in the manner as prescribed in the manner statute of the affiliating University. Pending constitution of Such C.D., the college will be run by an adhoc G.B. to be constituted with the approval of the affiliating University having the district Magistrate, where the college is logated in district boad quarter on the Sub-Divisional Officer in other cases, as President. The Principal of the college shall be the ex-office Secretary. Pending appointment of Principal, One of the representatives of the college shall act as Secretary.
 - (7) Bo special constitution of the G.B. shall be succepted by Goyt.
 - (8) Ferms and conditions for the purpose of affiliation laid down by the University are to be fulfilled.
 - (8) The college for the present, be affiliated in English, Bengali, Histrey, Economics, Pol. Science, Mathematics may be recommended by the affiliating to University;
- 2. The Governor is also pleased to approve of the creation of teaching and non-teaching posts in the college as detailed in the annaxure in the usual scales of pay w.e.f. 1995-66 session or from the date(s) f filling up the posts, whichever is later.

fonding staff, shall be appointed on the recommendation of the West Dengal College Service Commission Recruitment to Hon-teaching posts should be made subject to the observance of the recruitment rules of the college and Covt. circulars in this respect.

- The charge on account of payment of maintenance grant to the college will be not from the provision under the head "EUniversity & other Higher Education-VIII. Other expenditure—state Flan (Seventh Flan)—list. of New colleges including diversification of essential coursees of study in existing colleges—Grants—in—aid contributions" in the current year's " 277—Edn.(excluding Sports and Youth Wolfare)" in the State Budget.
