Sub-Establishment of a degree college at Balagarh
District of Hooghly.

The undersigned is directed, by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to approve of the proposal for the establishment of a degree college at Balagarh in the district of Hooghly w.s.f. the academic session 1985-86 subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- (1) The organisers shall have to provide the required land as assessed by the University Inspecting Team by way of registered deed, free from all encumbrances to the college authorities.
- (2) The organisers shall be required to provide adequate accommodation for conducting classes, office and teachers and Principal, essential furniture and common-room for students, equipment, books, etc for purpose of the college as per standard laid down by the University at their own cost:
- (3) In case of delay in constructing the permanent building the college authorities should provide a temporary structure consisting of at least three rooms.
- (3) Adequate sanitary arrangement i.e. toilets and urinals for students and members of staff shall be made.
- (4) Arrangement should be made for adequate supply of drinking water.
- (5) The college shall not be permitted to run Higher Secondary Courses.
- (6) The college will be run by a Governing Body to be constituted in the manner as prescribed in the statute of the affiliating University. Pending constitution of such G.B., the college will be run by an adhoc G.B. to be constituted with the approval of the affiliating University having the district Magistrate, where the college is located in district head quarter or the Sub-Divisional Officer in other cases, as President. The Principal of the college shall be the ex-officio Secretary. Pending appointment of Principal, one of the representatives of the college shall act as Secretary.
- (7) No special constitution of the G.B. shall be accepted by Govt.
- (8) Terms and conditions for the purpose of affiliation laid down by the University are to be fulfilled.
- (9) The college for the present, be affiliated in English, Bengali, History, Economics, Pol. Science, Mathematics may be recommended by the affiliating University ;

2. The Governor is also pleased to approve of the creation of teaching and non-teaching posts in the college as detailed in the annexure in the usual scales of pay w.s.f. 1985-86 session or from the date(s) of filling up the posts, whichever is later.

teaching staff, shall be appointed on the recommendation of the West Bengal College Service Commission Recruitment to Non-teaching posts should be made subject to the observance of the recruitment rules of the college and Govt. circulars in this respect.

3. The charge on account of payment of maintenance grant to the college will be met from the provision under the head "University & other Higher Education-VIII. Other expenditure- state Plan (Seventh Plan)- Estt. of New colleges including diversification of essential courses of study in existing colleges- Grants-in-aid contributions" in the current year's " 277-Edn.(excluding Sports and Youth Welfare)" in the State Budget.



sir,

I am directed to inform you that the Executive Council of this University considered the Inspection report dated 17.8.88 on the progress made by the authority of the Bejoy Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Balagarh in fulfilling the conditions stipulated earlier vide our letter No. IC/Affln./P/67/134/85 dated 30.9.85 while granting temporary affiliation w.e.f. 1985-86 & had been pleased to grant affiliation to the Bejoy Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Balagarh (Hooghly) on permanent basis w.e.f. the academic session 1988-89 subject to the provisions of the University Ordinances relating to conferment of degrees, titles etc. and also the directions as may be given by the University from time to time.

In this connection, the Executive Council had also been pleased to at immediate steps should be taken to make good the following deficiencies in fulfilling the conditions of affiliation which the college authority had so far failed to fulfill and, also to report compliance to the University forthwith.

- 1) that the college building should be completed within December, 1988;
- 2) that the approach road to the college terminating from STXK Road should immediately be repaired;
- 3) that a separate library room with an annexe of a reading room should be provided;

- 4) that four bighas of land as proposed to be transferred to the college should immediately be registered in favour of the college;
- 5) that the electrification of the college building should be completed as early as possible.

- vii) that books including text books and reference books worth Rs.3000/- for each subject of affiliation should immediately be purchased. Some journals should also be subscribed to ;
- viii) that the rates of tuition and other fees should not exceed the rates prevalent in the neighbouring Colleges ;
- ix) that the necessary arrangements for hostel for the students and quarters for teaching and non-teaching staff including the Principal should be made ;
- x) that a reserve fund of Rs.25000/- should always maintained and no portion of this amount including the interest accrued thereon should be withdrawn or utilised otherwise without the prior permission of the University ;
- xi) that the intake of students should not exceed 100 at present and that any increase in the intake of students should be made with the prior approval of the University ;
- xii) that a Governing Body of the College should be constituted in terms of new University St. 3 (G.B.) in vogue within 6 months from the date of receipt of this letter with an intimation to the inspectorate,

Pending constitution of the Governing Body under new University Statutes 3 (G.B.), the College will be run by an
